

## Logging into iTunes University at Philadelphia University:

1. Open your web browser.
  - a. iTunes University prefers the use of **Internet Explorer 6.0** on the PC and **Safari 2.0** on the MAC, but any browser can be used.
2. Go to: **<http://itunes.philau.edu/>**
  - a. If you do not have iTunes installed on your computer, click **Download iTunes 7** and follow the directions in the **Installing and Configuring iTunes 7.0** guide.
3. Click **click here to launch iTunes U**. The following window appears:

4. Click **Yes**.
5. A browser will open and iTunes will launch.
6. You will be prompted to login:



- a. Faculty/Staff:
    - i. Username: **philacol\your PhilaU username**
    - ii. Password: **your PhilaU password**
  - b. Students:
    - i. Username: **student\your PhilaU username**
    - ii. Password: **your PhilaU password**
  - c. Check **Remember this password in my keychain**.
7. Click **Log In**.

8. iTunes University @PhilaU appears in iTunes.
