***Summer Federal Work Study*** - Requires separate application available at [www.philau.edu/financialaid/workstudy](http://www.philau.edu/financialaid/workstudy)

***PELL Grant***-for undergraduate students only

***Federal Direct Stafford Loan*** - Must be enrolled at least half time-at least six (6) credits as an undergraduate or at least 4.5 credits as a graduate student. If you have not previously borrowed through the Direct Stafford Loan program, you must also complete a Master Promissory Note at [www.studentloans.gov](http://www.studentloans.gov)

***Federal Direct PLUS Loan*** - for parents of dependent, undergraduate students or graduate students. Must be enrolled at least half time-at least six (6) credits as an undergraduate or at least 4.5 credits as a graduate student. Apply at [www.studentloans.gov](http://www.studentloans.gov)
