Types of aid for summer

The following types of aid may be available for the summer. You must enroll in at least six (6) credits as an undergraduate and three (3) credits as a graduate student to be eligible for most aid program. There may be other program specific requirements that could limit your eligibility. Please check with your financial aid counselor if you have any questions.

PHEAA Grant – for undergrad PA residents only. Requires a separate application available at www.aessuccess.org.

Summer Federal Work Study – Requires separate application available at <http://egi.philau.edu/workstudy/WorkStudyLogin.aspx>

PELL Grant – for undergraduate students only

Federal Direct Stafford Loan – Must be enrolled at least half time – at least **six (6) credits as an undergraduate or at least three (3) credits as a graduate student**. If you have not previously borrowed through the Direct Stafford Loan program, you must also complete a Master Promissory Note **and** an entrance interview at www.studentloans.gov

Federal Direct PLUS Loan – For parents of dependent, undergraduate students or graduate students. Must be enrolled at least half time-at least **six (6) credits as an undergraduate or at least three (3) credits as a graduate student**. Apply at www.studentloans.gov
