Event: Kyle Noonan, a May 09 graduate, was diagnosed with leukemia just a few days into his new job. Kyle played baseball at PhilaU, and the baseball team and athletics department are sponsoring a bone marrow drive on campus today until 4 p.m. Kyle studied business and finance at PhilaU and is from Morristown, N.J.

The bone marrow drive is taking place in the Kanbar Campus Center Performing Space, just off Henry Ave., in East Falls. Samples will be taken via a swab from inside the potential donor's mouth and the information will be included in a national registry. This will not only help Kyle, but others who may find a match through this registry.
