Overview:

The Office of Information Resources would like to welcome you to Philadelphia University! All Philadelphia University students have access to the following OIR-supported resources below.

Requirements:

- **Username**: Your username is a combination of *your last name* and the last four digits of your student *ID number*.
- **Password**: Your password is the same for all of these accounts. You can reset your password under the "Web mail" icon at www.PhilaU.edu. For security purposes your password expires every 90 days, if you are having trouble logging into any of your accounts please first try resetting your password to correct the issue.

Along with your network account access, you will also receive a Philadelphia University e-mail account on Microsoft's Office 365 system. This account will be your main source for receiving communications from the University and from instructors.

10 GB of space is provided with this account. This resource is accessible from any computer with an internet connection, through a mobile device, and with an Mail client program such as Outlook.

WebAdvisor Account

WebAdvisor is a web-based information management tool that allows students to register for classes, check schedules and grades, and keep up to date with your student account balance and financial aid packages.

Blackboard Account

Blackboard is Philadelphia University's online, web-based learning platform. Many classes will utilize the Blackboard system to highlight course readings, reference websites, and receive materials for grading.

Campus Card Account

Deposit money to your Philadelphia University Campus Card for purchases on-campus. Your campus card can also be used at all Dining Services locations, most vending machines on campus, and in the Campus Store. This will also allow for color printing and plotting, as well as additional B&W prints if the 500 page quota per semester is exhausted.

Storage Resources:

Personal Web Space (Web Account)

Login: student\username (See "Requirements" section above for "username" information)

If you are interested in creating and maintaining your own web home page, you may request a directory on our University web server by contacting the Technology Help Desk to place a request. Your web account has a default capacity of 50 MB of storage; increases in storage space must be requested of OIR on your behalf by your professor.

• Home Directory Storage

• **Login**: username (See "Requirements" section above for "username" information)

Space is provided for academic file storage on our "Athena" server; we call this your 'home directory.' This directory enables you to securely maintain copies of files on our network which you may access online at any time with use of a VPN connection; see our Instruction Guides for details. Your home directory has a default capacity of 1 GB of storage; increases in storage space may only be requested by a professor. They should contact the Technology Help Desk directly with your information.

• SkyDrive Storage

Additional space is provided for academic file storage on Microsoft's Windows Live system; this space is called SkyDrive. This directory enables you to securely maintain copies of files online, available anywhere, with 7GB of available storage space.
