- The Midwifery Institute of Philadelphia University celebrates 10 years of educating midwives.
- Philadelphia University web site recognized by 10th Annual Webby Awards as Official Honoree.
- Psychology student Maria Maroun '06 was awarded a certificate of *Outstanding Abstract Submission by an Undergraduate Student in Psychology* at the Sigma Xi Student Research Symposium, held April 22 at Saint Joseph's University. Maroun's work, entitled *Does a Correlation Exist Between Road Rage and Music Preference?*, presented results from her senior psychology research project.
- One of three winners chosen to travel to Sturgis, S.D., to build his dream motorcycle last August, an episode featuring Associate Professor of Textile Engineering and Director of Graduate Programs Brian George's hot-rod bike will air on the Speed Channel's *Corbin's Ride On*, Monday, May 23, Tuesday, May 24 and Saturday, May 27.
