## FOCUS ON FACULTY

- Michael Rackover, Philadelphia University Physician Assistant Studies Program director, who recently completed a sabbatical at the National Human Genome Research Institute, published an editorial piece entitled, "**Embracing the New World of Personalized Medicine**," in the May 2007 issue of *JAAPA*, the peer-reviewed clinical journal of the American Academy of Physician Assistants. The piece discusses personalized health care and its relationship with genomic medicine, which is the application of chromosomal science.
