CAMPUS CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

As we approach the end of this academic year and move closer to the construction phase of our building projects, it is necessary for us to make two major changes in parking and traffic patterns.

Parking

Effective Monday, April 11, 2005, commuter student parking spaces along White House Drive between Althouse Hall and the A&D will be taken out of service. White House Drive will remain open and commuter students with the appropriate campus parking permits will still be able to park in available spaces between the A&D Center and School House Lane until the end of the semester.

Pedestrian Traffic

The lower portion of White House Drive will be too narrow to accommodate both vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Therefore, all pedestrians needing to walk to Althouse and other areas toward the end of Main Campus should use the walkway between Scholler and the White House. As always, please exercise caution when near the construction site.
