Tonight at the Academy of Music, Philadelphia University Fashion Industries Association presents the 2004 Fashion Show to a crowd of more than 2,000, including fashion industry representatives from Neiman Marcus, Jones Apparel, MothersWork, Urban Outfitters, students, parents and the public.

World-renowned fashion designer Mary McFadden will be presented with the 2004 Philadelphia Spirit of Design Award.

A past president of the Council of Fashion Designers of America and director of the Fashion Group from 1981-1982, McFadden was the recipient of the prestigious Coty Award in 1978 and 1979. She has since been elevated to the Coty Hall of Fame as well as the Best-Dressed List Hall of Fame.

The Annual FIA Fashion Show is the pinnacle event for Philadelphia University's Fashion Design Program. The student fashion designers will dazzle the crowd as professional runway models showcase their cutting-edge designs created with an innovative use of color and fabric. Moshe Safdie closes School of Architecture and Design Spring 2004 Series

The final speaker of the School of Architecture and Design Spring 2004 Lecture Series, Moshe Safdie, presented *Current Work* at the Tuttleman Center Auditorium April 21.

Safdie — an internationally recognized architect with firms in Boston, Toronto, and Israel — came to critical acclaim with his award-winning Habitat '67 project. Other projects of notoriety include Musée de la Civilization and the Western Wall Precinct Plan. Current projects include plans for the renovation and expansion of the Free Library of Philadelphia.
