### Philadelphia University Marks President Gallagher's 20th Anniversary and Hundreds Enjoy Homecoming and Reunion Weekend



The Board of Trustees, faculty, staff, students and alumni joined family and friends of President James P. Gallagher at the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts on Friday, October 1 to honor him on the occasion of his 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary as president of Philadelphia University.

*A trio of trumpeters led more than 300 Gala guests into the dining room for dinner and dancing.*

The event was also the official kick-off of the newly established James P. and Anne M. Gallagher Family Scholarship Fund.

In her remarks, Chair Betsy Gemmill commented that President Gallagher's efforts have resulted in the dramatic revitalization of Philadelphia University and she described the University's progress under his leadership – from major growth in academic programs to significant increases in applications and giving.

"Dr. Gallagher has been extraordinarily successful in putting together and leading a team of talented faculty and staff in transforming the institution and in enhancing Philadelphia University's stature both on a national and international level," Ms. Gemmill said. "As a result of his vision and with the help of many friends, faculty, staff and alumni, the University built Ronson Hall, Ravenhill Dining Hall, The Tuttleman Center and the award-winning Paul J. Gutman Library."

#### RefWorks: Managing Your Research Results

Students engaged in thesis research, group research projects, or who would like to more efficiently handle citation and documentation can all benefit from this tool. RefWorks allows you to manage your information through the creation of your own personal database, containing the citations and abstracts of articles, books, websites, and other sources. RefWorks is integrated with some of the online database systems at Gutman Library (ProQuest and Every index, for example), allowing citations and abstracts to be exported directly from these systems into your RefWorks database. This information can then be formatted into various documentation styles (MLA, APA, CSE, etc.) and can automatically create lists of cited works, and insert in-text citations too.
