As we discussed in the meeting last week, for the presentations on August 1, please use the following 8-slide format (attached). This outline is provided as a guideline – please make adjustments, as necessary. **Your presentations will be limited, however, to 10 minutes**, with 10 minutes for follow-up discussion.

Within this 8-slide format, ecosystem teams are encouraged to use a combination of visuals and text including diagrams, images, bullets, tables, etc. to represent the information requested for each slide.

The PowerPoint from the Performance Materials is attached for your reference. The strength of this team’s presentation is that they clearly articulated the new “core” sequence and its relationship to existing and new programs. With the design of the new programs, they also clearly describe how other programs, colleges, subject areas, etc. would interact with the new program – specifically where others could “plug-in.”

We have drafted relevant terminology for your reference at the end of this document. This is a draft of the terminology for the academic growth plan and new program development; please review and provide any suggestions, edits or comments.
