

What comes next for the Eco-Systems?

Curriculum Innovation Space (CIS)

1. Eight-slide PowerPoint of a **Concept** is developed.
(The framework developed in summer 2012 is the current template.)
2. **Pre-vetting:** Provost and Deans
3. **Sign off:** Provost and Deans as permission to move forward concepts further exploration
4. Concept comes to the Academic Operations and Oversight (AOO)
5. **AOO sends concept to CIS** with a developed membership (varies) and schedule for completion
6. **CIS incubates** and develops the concept into proposals and updates AOO on a regular basis
7. New programs with a “home” in a college, then go to **College Education Committees** for continued development and detailed review
8. Ecosystems that span colleges will be approved by AOO

Scheduling Parameters

New program launch timelines

- **Graduate Programs:** Launch 12 months after approval
- **Undergraduate Programs:** Launch 18 months after approval

CIS Framework:

- **Spring Semester:** Idea Generation
- **Summer Semester:** Eco-system & Program development
 - There will be fewer new ecosystems developed next summer
 - Incentives?
- **Fall Semester:** Logistics – Moving through the approval process
