- **Rocky (Re)Runs** exhibition at the DaVinci Art Alliance 704 Catherine Street in South Philadelphia
 - **Brief Description:** Exhibit **RockyReRuns** at the **DaVinci Art Alliance** April 18th-29th. Andrew Hart (Asst Prof. at CABE) was co-curator and exhibiting artist with John James Pron, AIA and eleven other artists including **Laura Blau** (Adj Prof CABE) and architects from Philadelphia and beyond looking at local to international impact of neighborhoods and culture of the '*Rocky run*' – the route portrayed in the original movie. Exhibitors addressed historical, current, and future pressures in the neighborhoods of north and south Philadelphia presented outside of the iconic mounting of the steps. The exhibit included artwork and an open conversation evening from **A. Thomas Schomberg** – sculptor of the 'Rocky Statue' –hosted by **Kenneth Jacobs** (Adj. Prof., CABE), the closing reception featured a presentation by Pulitzer winning author Michael Vitez and Pulitzer winning photographer Paul Gralish, authors of **Rocky Stories**.
